
First Holy Communion & First Reconciliation 2017-2018



Dear Parents/Guardians:

Please note that your child must be in school Year 3 or above to be considered for the programme. The course is aimed at children 7-8 years of age.

In the Eucharist, we receive Christ himself and it is therefore essential that your child is adequately prepared to receive this sacrament with reverence and understanding. This includes receiving forgiveness and our classes for First Holy Communion include preparations for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Our programme consists of ten classes between September 2017 and May 2018, with the First Holy Communion Sacrament being taken in June 2018. Your child must take part in **ALL** lessons. As joint parishes, the location of classes generally alternate between Holy Angels, Ash and Holy Family, Heath End.

We remind you that the role of the Catechists is secondary to you, the parent and there are also four 'parents' meetings which **YOU** will be required to attend.

You will find the dates for all classes, masses and meetings on the attached sheet.

At the first parents evening, it is requested that you complete a **COMMITMENT** form on behalf of your child and bring a **COPY** of their Baptism certificate.

As a family, you are requested to be **REGISTERED** with the parish. The completion of the application form **DOES NOT** automatically enrol your child on the course. You will receive confirmation by email/letter.

Father Robin has the overall authority to decide which children will be enrolled on the First Holy Communion course.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact First Holy Communion catechists and we look forward to meeting you at the first parents evening.
