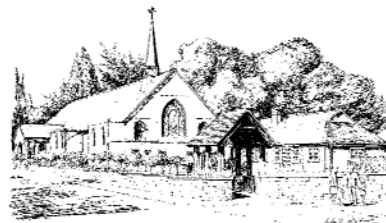

**Ash Wednesday** is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics for those aged 18-59. When fasting a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. Abstinence means not eating meat and this is applicable to all Catholics from the age of 14 and upwards.
