## Confirmation Programme

Our parishes will be running a confirmation programme leading to the celebration in May/June 2017. The programme will be open to Year 9 age group and above or slightly younger if the young person's level of maturity is considered appropriate. There will be signup sheets at the back of both churches which you are asked to fill in and hand to either Father Robin or Deacon John. Parents please note that the decision to join the Confirmation programme has to be the young person's personal choice and desire. The point of the programme is for our young people to explore and mature in their faith and then the decision is theirs to confirm their faith as an individual. The programme will kick off early October with parents being invited to the first meeting. Obviously regular mass attendance is essential.

## First Holy Communion

The First Reconciliation and Holy Communion programme will also commence at the beginning of September. The course is aimed at children aged 7-8 and your child must be in school Year 3 or above. In the Eucharist, we receive Christ himself and it is therefore essential that your child is adequately prepared to receive this sacrament with reverence and understanding.

## SS Margaret Clitherow, Anne Line & Margaret Ward

The 3 martyrs we commemorate on August 30th are numbered amongst the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales, who suffered death for the Catholic faith which had been outlawed in the kingdom. These three women – Ss Margaret Clitherow, Anne Line, & Margaret Ward – were all martyred because they protected Catholic priests from the Elizabethan authorities, who were seeking out all Catholic priests for execution. During this dark time in history, it was illegal for priests to be in the country, as it was illegal for Catholics to receive the Sacraments of the Catholic Church.

Although these three martyrs were canonized in 1970 among the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales, they are commemorated on a separate day because of the particular reason for their deaths; namely, their deep respect for the priesthood, and their zealous protection of priests.
