As reported to the AGM, we have recently had an independent review of the fabric of the church, the presbytery and the grounds, known as a quinquennial. This did not reveal any major issues other than a recommendation for a modernised kitchen, which the AGM endorsed and for which we have now obtained architect's drawings. There are however a very large number of relatively small recommendations like renewing the lines for the front car park bays and removing trip hazards. A conversation at St Hugh of Lincoln

Father Athanasius McVay in Conversation with Fr Alexander Lucie-Smith: On Monday 30th January at St Hugh of Lincoln, Knaphill, GU21 2AA. Father Athanasius is resident in Rome, a Canadian subject and a member of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, of which he is a distinguished historian. He will talk on a variety of subjects: the present situation in Ukraine; the ecclesial situation in Ukraine; the history and character of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church (an Eastern Church in communion with Rome, which numbers some 6 million members); the state of relations between Catholicism and Orthodoxy; the ways in which Latin Catholics can learn from their Greek brethren; and much else besides.Come and learn more about our Eastern brethren. All are invited and all are welcome. The evening starts at 8pm, and will end at 9.30pm. There will be time for questions from the floor.
