### Quinquennial Parish Property Survey

As reported to the AGM, we have recently had an independent review of the fabric of the church, the presbytery and the grounds, known as a quinquennial. This did not reveal any major issues other than a recommendation for a modernised kitchen, which the AGM endorsed and for which we have now obtained architect's drawings. There are however a very large number of relatively small recommendations like renewing the lines for the front car park bays and removing trip hazards. If there is anyone in the congregation which the kind of practical skills which your priest and finance committee lack and who would be prepared to give up a bit of time to help out with some of the tasks, Father Robin or Tim Flesher would be delighted to hear from you!

### Lent / Lent Groups

Lent is almost upon us. Ash Wednesday is 1<sup>st</sup> March. The Diocesan study this year revolves around Lectio Divina on the second reading of each Sunday, a key proclamation and reflection on passages from a book entitled "God is not angry" by Fr. Ian Petit OSB. His book gives an insight to the loving God who gives of Himself unconditionally to us. Deacon John thoroughly recommends it, having been privileged to have heard Fr. Ian in the flesh many years ago. As with all these studies of our Sunday scriptures they are better carried out in the week before which means we begin our study in the week commencing 27<sup>th</sup> February. As always these are better undertaken in groups but the material can also be used by individuals. Please put your name on the list at the back if you want a copy. If you are prepared to host a group please talk with Fr. Robin or Deacon John. It isn't about being learned or holy, it's about being welcoming and keeping things on track.

**Fr Robin will run a group on Saturday's at 4.15pm,** and during Lent the sacrament will be exposed for adoration from 5.00pm during the period when Fr Robin is available for Confession before the Vigil Mass. He is

also prepared to help with a group on Wednesdays after the morning mass as normal.

This powerful devotion helps us to walk with Jesus to the cross and helps us both draw close to him in this season and to understand what it means to be disciple who is also asked to take up our cross and follow him.
