Talk by Fr Peter Hughes

Father Peter Hughes, SSC will be giving a talk at Christ the Prince of Peace Weybridge on Saturday 15th July from 10:45 to 12:30pm (after the 10am mass) on *Listening to the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor* The response of the Church in Latin America to Pope Francis' call. Fr Peter Hughes is an Irish Columban priest from County Mayo who has spent most of his life as a missionary based in Lima, Peru.

As well as his work in some of the most desperately impoverished communities in Lima, Peter is an advisor to the Instituto Bartolome de las Casas and CELAM, the collegial council of Latin American bishops designed to

promote pastoral leadership, initiatives and inspiration for the 22 bishops conferences of Latin America and the Caribbean.
