World Mission Sunday

On Sunday 22 October the Church throughout the World will pray for the Missions and Missionaries. Also a Second Collection will be taken up to help support the Church where it is too young or too poor to support itself. This year Missio, the missionary charity for England and Wales, will be using any money raised to support South Sudan the world's youngest nation which was born out of war and civil strife. Please be as generous as you can to this cause.

In addition to this annual collection there are also a number of families in our two parishes who support the work of Missio throughout the year by having a Missio Red Box into which they put their spare change. As a result of the money raised during 2016 Missio helped meet the cost of training of 300 Mill Hill missionaries which saw the ordination of the first priest from Mongolia. Hopefully that will prove a catalyst for others in that country to come forward to test their vocation. Missio also helped with the building of 88 churches, chapels and convents, provided cycles for catechists in 26 parishes in Uganda and the installation of solar lights in St Mary's Cathedral and Our Lady of Fatima Church in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe. It also supported the work of the Church in some 98 dioceses across the world and assisted with the running of schools and medical centres. Perhaps you too might think about becoming a Red Box holder and by doing so helping support the work of the Church amongst some of the poorest communities in the world?
