CAFOD Lent Appeal 17th February. Please use the envelopes provided for your donation. And if you are a UK taxpayer, please *Gift Aid* your donation. Please note that CAFOD is chosen by the UK govt to earn (till 12 May) double the donation plus the 25% usual grant. **A £5 donation then becomes £11.25.** Please return envelopes and all donations by weekend 24th February.

Family Fast Day. 23rd February. We are encouraged to go without a meal this day, to eat simply, pray and reflect. Children and youth can go without their phone, tablet or sweet treats etc. for the day. - Holy Family are running a lunch - see above.

Give it up 1. As the parish supports the *Step by Step* homeless project in Aldershot, please consider giving up something during Lent and donating the money saved to support this worthwhile charity. More details by the church entrance.

Give it up 2. Please encourage your children to consider what they can give up for Lent and perhaps use the money saved to buy a CAFOD *World Gift* (e.g. mosquito net £7). Or the children can pool the money to buy a more substantial gift (e.g. community toilet £85).

Diocesan Consultation

For the past couple of months we have been talking, preaching, filling in questionnaires and having meetings about the future of our Parish. Our deliberations were initiated from Bishop Richards' message to us all about Diocesan re structure which will be required to fulfil the mission of the Church. Bishop Richard explained that these will be challenging times, especially when the ratio of Priests to people is in decline and difficult decisions will need to be made. He was keen to hear feedback from Parishioners across the Diocese and I thank you most sincerely for your contribution to these discussions. The questionnaires have been most helpful in many ways - gauging where we are as a Parish which is useful background for me to facilitate me in taking the Parish forward, and of course fulfilling the Bishops request for feedback from you all about the future and it's challenging times.
