Justice and Peace

If you want peace, work for justice (Pope Paul V1). From next week the 'Justice and Peace' team will launch the *Love in Action* programme, throughout which we will publish six key themes of <u>Catholic Social</u> <u>Teaching</u> which forms the basis of the Church's social mission and action. These themes are: *The Dignity and Equality of each human person. The call to participation and community. Preferential Option for the Poor. The Dignity and Rights of Workers. Solidarity among Peoples and the Promotion of Peace. Care for Creation.*

Share the Journey. Inspired by Pope Francis' special concern for migrants and refugees, we are all invited to join the *Share the Journey* campaign and a) call on governments to agree on two global 'compacts', b) sign a petition to the Prime Minister. Additionally, from May to September - in solidarity with people forced to flee - parishioners are invited to undertake a walk: e.g. to church (instead of car), in local park, a pilgrimage... whatever works for you – as individuals, families, or groups. Then we add your miles to a national grand total to encourage world leaders to step up in support of refugees and migrants worldwide too. Further details from Justice and Peace Team.
