Justice & Peace group

Day for Life Each year the Church dedicates this day to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. Therefore, please consider contacting your local MP to ask them to support the 'Conscientious Objection (Medical Activities) Bill' which would enshrine the rights of healthcare professionals not to participate in activities which go against their conscience, whether that is abortion, supply of the morning-after pill, euthanasia or the treatment of schoolchildren with puberty suppressant or cross-hormones. A sample 'Letter to MP' is available from a J&P team member after Mass, or you can send the letter directly to your MP by email from the website www.freeconscience.org.uk. There is also an informative display in St Mary's room. The proceeds of the Day for Life collection assist the work of the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other life-related activities supported by the Church. Human trafficking too is a growing concern.

Share the Journey. Inspired by Pope Francis' special concern for migrants and refugees, we are all invited to join the Share the Journey campaign and a) call on governments to agree on two global 'compacts', b) sign a petition to the Prime Minister - see display board. Additionally - in solidarity with people forced to flee - parishioners are invited to undertake a parish group walk (about 1.5 miles) on Sunday 22nd July after the 11A.M. Mass. We shall start and finish at the church. Alternatively parishioners may undertake their own walk: e.g. to church (instead of using car), in local park, a pilgrimage...whatever works for you. Then tell us and we shall add your miles to a national grand total, which will be used to encourage world leaders to step up in support of refugees and migrants worldwide too.
