Extraordinary month of Mission

Pope Francis has declared October 2019 to be an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM). This special month of prayer and action calls us all to renew our missionary commitment. Because we're all called to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with all peoples. For the four weeks of October 2019, the Holy Father has approved four themes:

- A personal encounter with Jesus Christ living in his Church.
- 2. The witness of missionary saints and martyrs.
- 3. Missionary charity as a commitment to support the Church's missionary activity and communities too poor to support themselves, through Missio.
- 4. Biblical, catechetical, spiritual and theological formation for mission.

The most helpful book Fr Robin has read on the new evangelisation and what it means for us as individual catholics is Scott Hahn's 'Evangelizing Catholics'. A good way of making a personal response to this call to mission would be to read this book.

There will be a reading group starting at on Saturday 2 November at Holy Angels at 10.00am, following on from an All Souls Mass in the morning. This is the first step towards forming a small mission group, but joining the reading group does not commit you to anything else. If you are interested but have not purchased the book, there are copies of the first couple of chapters available at the back of church to help you get started, to be read before the first meeting. Further dates are 16 Nov, 14 Dec, 18 Jan, 1, 15, & 29 Feb.
