SPUC (*Society for the Protection of unborn children*). "The 1967 Abortion Act which regulates abortion in England, Wales and Scotland, was never extended to Northern Ireland, meaning abortion remained illegal in most circumstances. Northern Ireland has had a proud history of defending the right to life. Pro-abortion MPs in Westminster have now succeeded in amending a routine Northern Ireland Governance Bill to impose abortion on the province. **Please write to your MP now and ask others to do the same.** If we don't, one of the most extreme abortion regimes in Europe will be imposed on Northern Ireland on 22nd October, with no consultation whatsoever with people there."

Extraordinary month of Mission

Pope Francis has declared October 2019 to be an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM). This special month of prayer and action calls us all to renew our missionary commitment. Because we're all called to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with all peoples. For the four weeks of October 2019, the Holy Father has approved four themes:

1. A personal encounter with Jesus Christ living in his Church.
2. The witness of missionary saints and martyrs.
3. Missionary charity as a commitment to support the Church's missionary activity and communities too poor to support themselves, through Mission.
4. Biblical, catechetical, spiritual and theological formation for mission.

The most helpful book Fr Robin has read on the new evangelisation and what it means for us as individual Catholics is Scott Hahn's 'Evangelizing Catholics'. A good way of making a personal response to this call to mission would be to read this book.
