We are encouraging everyone to read Scott Hahn's 'Evangelizing Catholics' as a good way of engaging with the call for each one of us to engage with the new evangelization.

'The New Evangelization is the work of the whole church - lay, ordained, and consecrated. It's about friends, family, and coworkers reaching out to one another and proclaiming the truth of Christ... it's about simple acts of kindness, simple challenges issued in love, and simple questions asked with sincerity.' (Evangelizing Catholics p.13)

There will be a 'reading group' meeting at Holy Angels on Saturday mornings at 10am on 16 Nov (Ch.3&4), 14 Dec, 11 Jan (TBC), 1, 15, & 29 Feb. Hopefully this will encourage us all to make progress reading through the book whether we can meet together or not. Each meeting will stand alone to look at the relevant chapters as we read through the book, so don't feel inhibited from coming along if you cant meet together each time.

This is the first step towards forming a small mission group, but joining the reading group does not commit you to anything else. Louise's story: I have been in and out of the care system since I was very young, I fell in with some dangerous people and got hooked into prostitution, drugs and alcohol, committing crimes to help support my habit. I was absolutely destitute, dirty and down. I felt lost and trapped in this life style. In and out of hostels and prisons, and sometimes sleeping on the streets. One day someone told me about a women's centre called women@thewell and how I could get help. I got assigned a named worker there who helped me address problems and helped me to get into accommodation. Now I feel like I have managed to get my act together.
