Sunday of the Word of God

The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is now Sunday of the Word of God. Parishes across the world are encouraged to make God's Word their focus this week as we celebrate the first Sunday of the Word of God, instituted by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter *Aperuit Illis*. In this letter, the Pope offers advice and encouragement for reading the Bible. We have uploaded a copy to the parishes' websites, where the January newsletters are.
