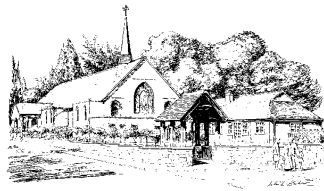
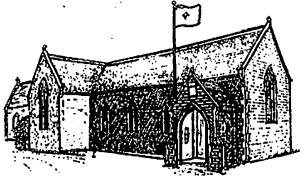

CHURCH OPEN FOR PRIVATE PRAYER DURING LOCKDOWN

Fr Robin will open the church at which he celebrates Mass each day for private prayer 30 minutes before he celebrates Mass. The Lord will be exposed on the Altar for Adoration during private prayer.

Fr Robin will celebrate Mass at the church he normally does, as set out in the diary on page 1 of the newsletter, so you can attend your normal church for prayer. The only exception to this is Sunday Mass which can only be celebrated once, and will be at Holy Angels Church.

In addition, each Sunday evening, we will be alternating opening one of the churches for an hour of Adoration and private prayer, see page 1 of the newsletter for details.

Please note that, as public worship is not permitted during lockdown, we would respectfully ask that you vacate the church 10 minutes before Fr Robin celebrates Mass.

All the usual provisions apply if you visit for private prayer, so please remember:-

- The wearing of face masks continues to be compulsory and 1m+ distancing is to be maintained - please be careful with this if you see friends while at church.**
- Please use the hand sanitisers on arrival and departure.**
- Track and trace - please either use the QR code with the NHS contact tracing app, or bring a slip giving your contact details**
- Please place a prayer sheet on your chair when you leave so we can clean the area for others to use.**
- There is a one way system in place in both churches.**
- All toilets are closed for the time being.**
- Maximum capacity at Holy Family is 36 in church (depending on bubbles) and 10 overflow in the hall. At Holy Angels 30 in church (mainly in bubbles of three) and 9 overflow in the hall.**
