


Some people have asked if it is still possible to give Fr Robin a personal gift. This is allowed by the Bishop, but would need to be done via an Easter Card for Fr Robin and his family and not via the Easter collection.

Lent

Our Lent Bible study continues this Sunday at 4.30 pm- looking at the Liturgy of the Eucharist - a good preparation for our celebration of maundy Thursday.

Reconciliation / Confession - We are now back in a position for regular confession times to resume. Fr Robin is available to hear confessions before the Saturday evening Mass, and on Thursday evenings at Holy Family before mass. He is often available after mass as well if you ask him, or by appointment.

Our Invited mission is back! We can't wait to welcome new, and returning members of our Invited family.

Our Invited mission began last year, bringing people from across the Diocese (and far beyond) together in faith, online. Season II launches after Easter during Eastertide – the weeks between Easter and Pentecost, with the first of 6 episodes premiered on our website on Monday 18 April.

A new episode will be released on our Invited webpage every Monday during the Easter Season enabling you to watch great speakers, hear wonderful testimony, and engage in a time of prayer and reflection. Each film will be followed by an in person parish group or an online diocesan wide online conversation on Thursday evenings - beginning 21 April. YOUTH GROUP Our Youth Group meets once a month on the first Saturday of the month after the 5.30pm Mass and finishes approx. 8.15pm. We have been lucky enough to meet face to face as a group over the last few months taking into account hygiene and Covid cleaning etc. The Youth Group is open to anyone in Yr 7 and above. The following dates are the planned dates for the next few months. **Saturdays** 2nd April, 7th May, 4th June, 2nd July.

Have you heard about Step by Step? This local charity in Aldershot has been on our Youth group and parish radar for many years. It is a charity for children between 16-23 yrs old who find themselves homeless and in most cases on the streets. Our Youth group agreed we would put out a call to parishioners to help us resource NEW 4.5 tog single duvets and duvet sets (no pillows thank you). I have costed these items up say from Dunelm/Asda to be about £25 max for both the duvet and duvet cover and pillowcase. During our discussions our mathematician Peter worked out that would be £4.17/week (without a calculator) and Immy added this would be a sacrifice of one barista coffee or a glass of wine a week over the 6 weeks of lent. **CAN YOU JOIN US IN OUR LENTEN GIVING?**

Entering into the Passion

We do well then to contemplate Our Lord's Passion: in our personal meditation, when reading the Gospel, in the sorrowful mysteries of the Holy Rosary, in The Way of the Cross ... sometimes we imagine ourselves to be there, present amongst those who witnessed those moments. We take a seat among the Apostles during the Last Supper, when our Lord washed their feet and spoke to them with infinite tenderness, at the supreme moment of the institution of the Sacred Eucharist. We picture ourselves as one more among the three who slept at Gethsemane when the Lord hoped that we would accompany him in his infinite loneliness; as one amongst those who heard Peter swear that he did not know Jesus; as one who heard the false testimonies at that travesty of a judgement and saw the Chief Priest make a great show of being shocked at Jesus' words; as one in the thick of the mob that screamed out for his death and saw him hoisted up on the cross on Calvary.

We put ourselves among the onlookers and see the disfigured yet noble face of Jesus. Astonishingly, we feel his infinite patience. With the help of grace, moreover, we can also try to contemplate the Passion of Christ as He himself lived it.[600] It seems impossible, and of course it will always be a very impoverished view compared with the reality of what in fact took place, but it can become for us an extraordinarily rich source of prayer.
