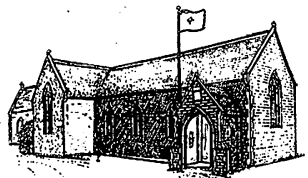
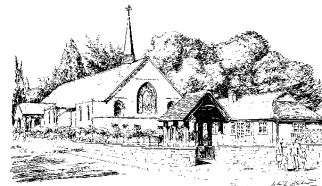

World Communications Day takes place on Sunday 29 May. On this day we are encouraged to take up the command of Jesus to preach the Good News of the Gospel to the whole world.

The title of this year's message from Pope Francis is 'Listening with the Ear of the Heart'. By exploring this theme we are invited to reflect that listening involves more than simply hearing, and that true listening is an important component of genuine relationships - and is foundational to the relationship between God and humanity.

St Peters, Ash, as part of Churches Together has invited Holy Angels parishioners to a Jubilee afternoon tea on Saturday 4th June 2022 at 4pm. Tea will be in the rectory gardens but if weather is inclement then it will be in the church hall.

St Titus Brandsma was canonised by Pope Francis on 15th May 2022. He was a Dutch Carmelite who was killed for his heroic resistance to Nazi pressure on Catholic media outlets to betray their principles.
