CAFOD is part of the Disasters Emergency Committee and is one of the UK's 15 leading aid charities to raise funds quickly and efficiently in times of crisis overseas. The charity have launched a Syria Turkey Emergency Appeal in response to the Earthquakes that hit the region last week. To date 35,000 people are known to have died, with 17 million people directly affected by the tragedy.

Donations to CAFOD's Syria Turkey Appeal will be used to provide shelter, food, water and emergency medical assistance as well as winter kits to help people cope with the freezing temperatures. CAFOD is also in touch with its sister agency, Caritas Turkey, who work in the region. They are currently assessing needs and delivering essential humanitarian aid.
