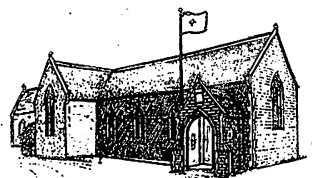
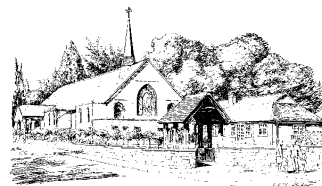

### Offertory

**We are experimenting with reintroducing the offertory collection in the mass.** For many of us the DONA machine will continue to be the preferable way to give (in which case let the basket pass you by!), but this enables us to acknowledge the collection as we symbolically lay it before the altar and for those who still use cash will make it easier to differentiate between main offertory collection and the second collections when we have them.

The DONA machine and second collection basket will remain at the door, and standing order forms are available there as well. We need at least £750 a week (in each parish) to meet our obligations - which is raised through your generous donations. Thank you.

### Second Collection 12/13 August Verona Fathers / Comboni Missionaries

*The Comboni Missionaries (alias Verona fathers) and their work*

*The Comboni Missionaries, commonly known as "Verona Fathers", are a specifically international missionary Order of priests and lay-brothers who were founded in 1867 by St Daniel Comboni. They draw their members from thirty-five countries.*

*They mainly work in many African, Central & South American and Asian countries.*

*Their aims, as Missionaries, are as follows: proclaim the Gospel where Christ is unknown, To foster Gospel values, especially those of justice & peace. To promote human development, both spiritual and material, + education both formal and vocational for boys and girls + health-care + clean water, To serve and support the young Churches-To encourage and create conditions for material and spiritual self-sufficiency To promote the missionary vocation and missionary partnership*

### Sacramental Programs 2023 - 2024

#### First Holy Communion

Children of Yr.3 and upwards **who are attending mass** are ready to be prepared to participate more fully in the sacraments. Forms and program dates are now available.

The course will begin with a parents meeting on Tuesday 12 September at 7.30pm and meetings are Saturday mornings. We are usually oversubscribed and have to turn some people away so please register early and begin to attend church regularly now if you need to re-engage with the mass. #### Confirmation (Youth)

We expect that we will have the numbers to run a young people's confirmation group this year. Please contact the parish office to express interest now. The usual age is around Yr 9 or mature Yr. 8 and above.

Confirmation is the time when we pray for the Holy Spirit to confirm, strengthen and encourage us in our life off faith. For young people it is a point where they begin to affirm for themselves that they want to live as Christians.
