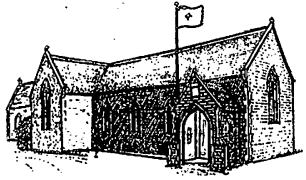
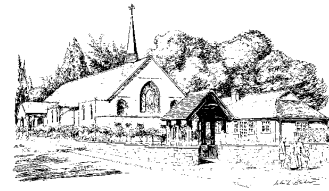

Holy Angels AGM – April 28 12.30pm

St Mary's, Ash Vale will be hosting the service for the [Women's] World Day of Prayer this year on Friday 1st March at 7.30pm and the service has been prepared for us by an ecumenical group of Christian Women from Palestine. The worship service shares stories which illuminate the experiences of three Palestinian Christian women from three different generations, who witness to the power of bearing together in love. The service was prepared long before the current situation in Gaza, and seems very Inspired.

Diana Johnson has tabled a new extreme abortion up to birth amendment ahead of Report Stage of the Government's flagship Criminal Justice Bill.

This proposed extreme change to the law would likely lead to a tragic increase in the number of babies' lives being ended through late-term abortions performed at home.

Pro-abortion campaigners are flooding MPs' inboxes with emails asking them to put their name to the new amendment and vote in support of it at Report Stage.

It is vital at this point that MPs see that they have a large number of constituents who are opposed to this extreme change to the law and they must not support this amendment.
