

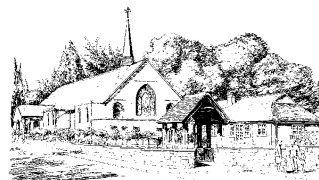

**In order to begin the process of preparing for
baptism you are expected to be already
attending church with your child on a weekly
basis for at least 2 months. In choosing to baptize
your child you are promising to bring them up as a
Catholic, which of course includes bringing them to
mass with you. Application forms are then available
for you to fill in at the back of church – which need
to be singed by Fr Robin – and then given in to the
parish office so we can invite you to a baptism
preparation morning.**
