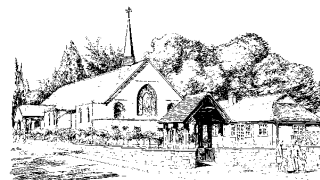

Journey towards the New Parish Structures

It has now been confirmed that the new parish of
Guildford will be inaugurated before the end of the
year, comprising the 13 churches which make up
our current Guildford Deanery.

Thank you to everyone who was able to attend the
open parish meetings to think about the future and
reflect on the need to change our present structures
to ensure that there is a sustainable way of offering
mass and pastoral care locally in the future.

The two key things we need to reflect on are:

1. How to balance our need to be both committed
to the flourishing of the individual church
communities (Holy Angels and Holy Family) and
the "hub" pastoral areas.

2. How to balance a realistic sense of hope for the
future with a recognition that it will be difficult to
provide Sunday mass in the coming years at all our
existing churches across the present Deanery. Think
for a moment about how we might manage St
Joan's, Holy Angels and Holy Family with only
priest – not an unrealistic prospect in the not too
distant future.

There is lots of information on the Diocesan
website to help us think about the coming changes.
The Bishop's webinar from last year is helpful as is
the written version of the pastoral plan.

**Youth Confirmations – we are collecting names
to see if we can run a group this year.**

Names need to be submitted to the parish office by
9 august - and application forms will be out at the
back of church.

Normally this for children in school year 10 (15
years old by the time of confirmation).

First Holy Communion 2025

We are taking applications for First Holy
Communion. This for children who will be 7 so this
usually means school year 3 or above and is for
those who attend mass regularly so that they begin
to participate more fully in the mass.
