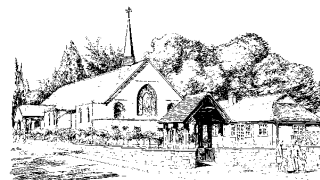

We are gathering together as a Diocese to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Hope, the 60th Anniversary of the Diocese, and our continuing mission in these present times.

The celebration will take place at the South of England Showground in Ardingly, with capacity for 1,200 people to attend.

We have a number of guest speakers scheduled to inspire and uplift us. The topics are as follows:

- Communities of Hope - Michelle Moran (Sion Community)
- Scriptures of Hope - Dai Woolridge (Bible Society)
- Missionaries of Hope – Rev. Greg Bakker (Church Mission Society)

We will also be joined by One Hope Project, a Catholic Worship Collective who will assist us with our music and those involved in our diocesan Schools Singing Programme will also be with us for the day.

Families are being encouraged to attend, as there will be a 'youth stream' allowing younger members of our congregations to engage with the virtue of hope in a way that is accessible for them. There will also be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament available throughout the day.

The day will finish with Mass.

The festival is free to attend, but it is recommended that members of the Parish travel by coach, the cost of which will be covered.

Sacramental Programs

We are beginning both First Holy Communion and Confirmation programs.

There are application forms available and we now have dates for the First Holy Communion programme available. The program begins with a parents meeting on Tuesday 23 September 7.30pm at Holy Angels. Applications must be received before then and parents are reminded that First Holy Communion is for children who are part of families who are regularly attending mass.

Youth Confirmations – it is not too late to accept names for the program

Names need to be submitted to the parish office ASAP - and application forms are out at the back of church.

Normally this for children in school year 10 (15 years old by the time of confirmation).

Confirmation is for those who feel they are ready to make the commitment themselves to be Catholics, including accepting the mass obligation incumbent on all Catholics.

Help needed

In order for our churches to offer the range of spiritual, sacramental and practical support and help we wish to we need members of the congregations to be willing to help.

There are a number of things that happen only because of a small number of committed people to whom we are very grateful.

Especially at the moment we need people to help with our young people's programs.

For those of you not called to work with children but who are interested in helping with more adult faith formation we also need help with baptism, and marriage preparation and RCIA.
