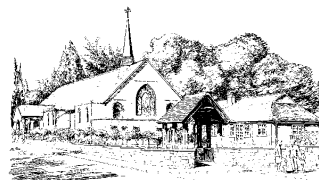

Following Bishop Richard's recent pastoral letter it has now been confirmed that **Guildford Deanery will become the new Parish of Guildford at the start of Advent.** Our church communities will continue to be the places in which the Gospel is proclaimed and the sacraments celebrated, and to be led by priests assigned to them, as at present.

Working together will help us to be more effective in our prayer, formation and mission. Fr Robin, together with Fr Simon will look after Farnham, Ash & Heath End, which will together form a 'hub' as part of the larger Parish.

Bishop Richard will celebrate Mass at 6pm on Saturday 29th November at St Joseph's Guildford at which the new parish will be entrusted to its team of priests and Fr Jonathan will take possession as their moderator. As many as are able from across the deanery, especially our parish, are warmly encouraged to attend.
