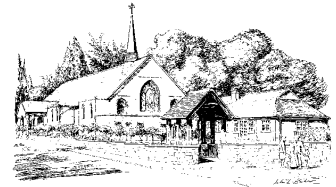

(And while as a married priest Fr Robin is remunerated by the parish slightly differently it is still your offertory which provides for this.) The offertory basket will of course be available before and after Mass, but do not forget the Dona machine which will include a special button for the Easter offering.

### **Sunday April 19 - 4.30pm Holy Angels**

The Bishops of England and Wales have asked Catholics to join them in a Holy Hour to pray for the promotion of a culture of life in our lands. This is to present a unified, prayerful front to offer this petition to Our Lord for the dignity of life from conception to natural end and to pray that assisted suicide will not become law.

In a Lenten statement, the Archbishop of Liverpool, the Most Reverend John Sherrington, reaffirmed the Church’s principled objection to the Terminally Ill (Adults) End of Life Bill, and urged Catholics to pray for parliamentarians debating the Private Members’ Bill in the House of Lords. Archbishop Sherrington, the Lead Bishop for Life Issues for the Bishops’ Conference, asked for a special prayerful focus on those who are suffering near the end of their lives and those who care for them.

Easter has always been seen as a time to enter into a newness of the faith after the celebration and renewal of our baptism.
